

4. (fmr) GLOVATSKIY Secret traitor, Boris MOGRITSKIY, born 30 May 96, a Ukrainian whose last known address was Herxfeld, Kriegsschule DP camp, was an agent dropped without prejudice on 13 Jun 49. Annex B, Dropped Agents List, 1 Sep 49.

5. Petro VOLODYCHIK no trace.

6. Igor GORDEYEVSKAYA ZHURIVSKAYA

(a) Attached for NID is a copy of subject's ZILARPS file.

(b) ZHURIVSKAYA, I.: Member of press section of German-Ukrainian Society. EKZ-6172, 13 Dec 54 (KGB received a copy).

7. (fmr) KOZAK (presumably Volodimir KOZAK):

(a) KOZAK, Volodymyr, born 20 Mar 10, residing Munich, Reichsstrasse 5, was a delegate to the Congress of Ukrainian (ZChOUN) Nationalists in London on Jun 53. He comes from Germany. OIA-220, 21 May 53.

(b) KOZAK, Volodimir is a close associate of Michael KORN who, according to COM files is an employee of ZIFFER. Traces in CIE files show KOZAK as a member of the SB in Munich. IV-28555 3-309323; 14 Aug 52; Subject KORN, Michael.

(c) KOZAK, fmr: [] reported to the KGB that the BOGATIRCHIK and KOZACH factions of the OUPD had definitely split, KOZACH attacking the UVF and demanding recognition as chief of the OUPD. KNA-144, 12 Jun 53.

(d) (Captain) Volodymyr KOZAK was a former officer of the "Galicia" division. ARCAPELIN conferred with KOZAK during ARCAPELIN's investigation of the anti-communist Atanas PILOK, also a former member of the "Galicia" division. PILOK, active with the Ukrainian Central Committee, had been accused of the misuse of "Galicia" division funds for widows and orphans. KOZAK told ARCAPELIN the accusations were untrue. EKPA-9613; 27 Jan 54.

(e) Vladimir KOZAK, according to [] was elected to the Directorate of the Ukrainian Refugee Congress, 14-16 Aug 53, which was controlled by a fused group of the DANZIGA-KIEVIAN bloc of "westerners" vs. "easterners" who received only minor posts. KNA-10292; 17 Mar 54.

(f) Volodimir KOZAK: See CAMILL Report: KNA-7218, KNA-7367, KNA-9949, KNA-10297, dated 30 Jun 52, and EKPA-12556, dated 26 Sep 54.

8. Karl MAJKE: No trace.

9. Ivan LYSKOVICH was a member of the Plenum (Rida TIPUN) of the Ukrainian Congress of Refugees, 14-16 Aug 53. (See par 7 above). [] info on this

Congress was from Deputy Ataman of the Ukrainian Free Comanks General Vagan CORBANYUK and members of the Directorate of the UVRA (Ukrainian Liberation Movement) Vladimir ZOLOTAROVICH.

10. Dmitri MIKULIN: No further traces
11. (Dr) Ivan MITYA (MITYA): No further traces
12. (Dr) (fmu) MUROVICH: No trace
13. Andrei Jur'evich MIKULIN:

a. Andrij MIKULIN, residing in Buenos Aires, came from Argentina as a delegate to the Congress of Ukrainian Nationalists in London on 20 Jun 53. QSLA 2205, 21 May 53.

b. Andrej MIKULAS, residing Praha 7, Komnovom u. no. 5, is named by Source (Czech Refugee G/256) as the Slovakian commercial engineer husband of Eva MIKULASOVA on whom there is a HEDOP special report. HQMA 7458, 2 Sept 53.

c. Captain Andrij MIKULIN is listed by CAPILIN as one of his sources for his 28 Jun 53 report on the suspicious activities of Bishop Oleksiy PHILIPENKO of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church. PHILIPENKO was suspected as a Soviet agent penetrating the Church. MIKULIN was described by CAPILIN as a ZCOUN leader in Argentina recently visiting in Germany. HQMA 7763, 23 Sept 53.

d. Andrij MIKULIN: If NCB does not have CAPILIN Report HQMA 6444, 30 Jun 53, subject: Andrij MIKULIN, COM will send a copy on request.

14. Petro PASHNIAK:

a. PASHNIAK, possibly identical with PASHNIK, fmu ZCOUN member. HQMA 12566, 26 Sept 54, CAPILIN Report

b. PASHNIAK, (fmu) born ca 1899, was BANDERA man in Munich. HQMA-11584, 24 Jun 54, quoted in trace request.

15. Friedrich ROEDER:

a. Friedrich ROEDER, [] reports that ROEDER is Secretary General and legal advisor of the Export Club in Munich. The Expert Club, backed by wealthy German industrialists, conducts discussions on current political problems and on economic trading possibilities. The Club is closely connected with Europa Union, of which ROEDER is one of the leaders. [] first met ROEDER through SEMIONOV and CAROLATH in 52 and has continued the contact as it was [] job in S-2 to cover Rightist political affairs in that district.

He felt ROEDER, a Rightist by inclination, and a former member of the Rosenberg Ministry, might be useful. [] reports, however, that ROEDER is rather wordy but gives out little important information, and that ROEDER is rather wordy, but gives little important information, and that ROEDER is valuable only because he has good contacts which he probably built up during the Rosenberg days...Soviet emigration contacts which ROEDER still maintains. [] knew no names of such contacts but felt he could name some when necessary. Because of the Rosenberg stamp on ROEDER, [] is extremely skeptical of him. ROEDER can be reached through the Expert Club, Karlsplatz 11/12, Munich, Att. B, p. 18, EDDA 6322, 21 Oct 53.

b. Dr. Friedrich ROEDER is an active, unpaid informant of [] with no known ZISPER connections. ROEDER's affiliation with some German agency is possible. He provides [] with miscellaneous local German information. EDDA 13171, 16 Nov 54.

c. Dr. Friedrich ROEDER, executive director of the Expert Club is listed as one of the Germans participating in the founding of the "Deutsche-Russische Antikommunistische Gesellschaft" (See para 3 a above) NOKA 8067, 1 Sept 51.

d. If MOB does not have copy of the following, please request Report, EDDA 9808, 19 Feb 54, Att A: "Conference with Friedrich ROEDER on Questions of Eastern Politics".

17. Ivan SHARELSKY:

e. Ivan SHARELSKY, according to [] was elected as Chairman of the Controlling Commission of the Ukrainian Refugee Congress, 14-16 Aug 53, which was controlled by a fused group of the BANDERA-HELMAN bloc of "Westerners" vs the "Easterners" who received only minor posts. EDDA 10292, 17 Mar 54.

b. Peter Ivan SISKUPSKI-BORG is a former associate of White Russian General SISKUPSKI in Berlin. SISKUPSKI in 1924-25 in Munich organized the MLADOROSSOV Party, a monarchist legitimist party which aimed to gather Russian emigrant youth around the newly "crowned Tsar", Grand Duke Cyril. This party fell in 32 under SISKUPSKI's assistant (Col) Vm. VODUTOV; then in Berlin, who used the organization as an intelligence collecting agency for the Soviets, especially in the Balkans. The party collected info on activities of White Russian anti-Sov groups and penetrated the MSNP as well as the RDS. 18. Volodimir SLIMAKOVSKY:

(a) (Engineer) ~~Volodimir SLIMAKOVSKY~~ is mentioned by Marianne Elisabeth KORZHAN: "From my first day in Munich, from my first meeting with GINA VILIPOVICH and her husband, from my first encounter with Engineer ~~SLIMAKOVSKY~~... I felt everyone suspected me of having been sent to Munich by the Bolsheviks." EOMA-12163; 17 Aug 54
(Subject: Appearance of Michael KORZHAN's wife in Munich).

(b) ~~SLIMAKOVSKY~~, Volodimir, lives at a government camp in Munich-Moosach, Seehamerstr 4. AECAPELIN: EOMA-11836; 16 Jul 54.

(c) Moledymyr ~~SLIMAKOVSKY~~ is carded to MOBA-8530, date unknown, and MOBA-10577, 22 July 52. Neither of these dispatches can be located in COM files; it is requested that SSR send us copies if possible. MOB may have MOBA-8530 which appears to have been an AECAPELIN report.

19. Yuri STUDINSKY:

(a) Yuri STUDINSKY was a member of the Frente (Rada INPIEN) of the Ukrainian Congress of Refugees, 14-16 Aug 53, (see Para 7 above) EOMA-10292; 17 Mar 54.

(b) STUDINSKY, cited as son of the late well known Ukrainian scholar, AECAPELIN, EOMA-4699, 30 Mar 53.

(c) Yurii STUDINSKY, (professor) at the Free Ukrainian University and guest lecturer in economics and social problems, is listed as among the prospective teaching personnel of a proposed Ukrainian Cadre School. The school, to be controlled overtly by CASSOWARY 1 as a recruitment and training program for agents in current operations in the Ukrainian SSR, was planned to offer, overtly, all-emigre refresher courses in patriotic anti-communism. Its proposed site was near Weilheim, Bavaria, ca 40 km southwest of Munich. EOMA 2359; 11 Dec 52.

(d) Georg von STUDINSKY, born 1903 in Lvov, residing 13b Starnberg, Wittelsbachstr 14/II, professor at the Ukrainian Free University in Munich, was subject of trace request. SFROB 3133; 26 Oct 54.

(e) Prof. Yurii STUDINSKY reported via CAPELIN on the creation of a new Ukrainian Party. (Report includes info on STUDINSKY.) If MOB has no copy of this report, please request same. Att. E to EOMA 4699; 30 Mar 53; CAPELIN REPORT.

(f) Yurii STUDINSKY, aka Jurij STUDINSKY was one of the outstanding Ukrainian emigre journalists. He contributed to Sichasna Ukraina (Ukraine Today), the official organ of XPUHVR (Foreign Representation of the Ukrainian Chief Liberation Council). HICOG Biographical Roster of Russian and National Minority Emigre Personalities, 2617, p. 66; 17 Mar 53.

20. Grigorij USCIAKOLO:

(a) Grigorij Petrowitch USCIAKOLO, born 15 Mar 20, is listed as Identity 137 on the AEPAM membership list. No indication he is presently active. Check SCOPES. EOMA-7006; 29 Jul 53.

(b) (Col) USHKALOV: Col Aleksei Pavlovich KUROCHKIN, alias Roman Pavlovich SAKHAROV, a later defector, served in a motor company as an army private serving the Central Group of Forces in Baden as a passenger car driver in the second platoon, from Mar 51 until his desertion in Sep 51, during which time he was driver for (Col.) KRAZAVIN, Deputy Chief of Signal TeGov and for Col. USHKALOV, Chief of Personnel (Cadre) TeGov, MOA-7642; 29 Nov 51.

(c) Frau USHKALOV: Card states was political leader of a Rayon Otdel (MO d. RPP; Det #6401) Ref: USSR: GLD-D; 25 Dec 42. Document not available.

21. Rostislav YENDIK

(a) (Dr.) Rostislav YENDIK, Boris LEVITIN and Prof. Vasil Antonovich SHULYA and the entire ZP/UHVR complex are listed as the present friends of Ivan VLASTYUKO, leader of the UDPR-Left and a contributor (journalist is under pseudonym Ivan KORSUN) to Suchsna Ukrainska, the ZP/UHVR organ published in Munich. CAPELIN REPORT: EDNA 5008, 15 Apr 53.

(b) A copy of EDNA 9640; 29 Jan 54 is attached hereto for RHE.

22. Oleksy ZAPOROZETS

(a) ZAPOROZETS, (frau) is cited as president of the L'vivski Rayon Executive Committee, headquartered in Ul Stalina No. 2-4, formerly Ulisa Lazynowska, which is listed as the fifth Rayon Party Committee under the Lvov Rayon Party Committee. U.S. MSC/RIV/424; 13 Jan 47; Subject: Work Method of the Soviet Party Apparatus in West Ukraine.

(b) ZAPOROZETS, frau, is cited as an engineer, residing Wasserburgstr 29, Munich, and as a contact of the Czech Frau LAZINA, who was arrested by US authorities, apparently for espionage, on 10 Sep 46. Another of LAZINA's contacts in Munich was (Dr) ROMEO, Bad Brunnhallerstr. 3, who told a woman companion to keep LAZINA out of Munich because the Americans were going to arrest him. Azon MSC 135; 2 Oct 45; also CIS file, LTS 554, 1 Oct 46. Neither of these documents can be located in COM files.
