SUBJECT: GENERAL - REDWOOD/LC IMPROVE/[] OPERATIONS

SPECIFIC - Report of [] meeting with the RIS in Brussels on
14 and 15 August 1958

Reference: MUNI-9234

1. On 14 and 15 August 1958 [] met with an RIS representative in Brussels. The RIS representative introduced himself as Nikolai (LNU), and he turned out to be one of the staffers [] had met in Karlsruhe in September 1957. (See attachment B to EXMA-29561 for [] earlier description of this staffer). The first of these two meetings was held at the Fair, specifically over lunch in the Canadian pavilion, the initial contact having been made in the Soviet pavilion. This first meeting was of several hours duration and was primarily devoted to a quick rundown of [] work for the RIS, getting acquainted and to NIKOLAI's giving [] instructions as to what he should prepare for the next meeting which was held on the following day. The second meeting took place in the city of Brussels, in a cafe and on the street, and lasted approximately four hours. As he was instructed at the first meeting, [] prepared a written report on various topics, which report he gave NIKOLAI, followed up by a verbal report on the same and other topics. (See attachment B for [] reconstruction of the written report he gave NIKOLAI.)

2. A summary of the meeting, keyed to headings listed below and the details of which can be found in attachment A, is as follows.

3. Debriefing by the RIS: Including people and thin [] wrote about in his report on 15 August for Nikolai, he was asked about and reported on the following:

- a) The RFE installation in Munich and Brussels, its activities, personnel, locations, and other related data.
- b) AEGASSOMARY 2 and 27.
- c) Anton GRABER.
- d) []
- e) [] and his wife.
- f) Yakiv MAKOVETSKYY.
- g) AE CIPE LIN - !

6. Mikolaj: Don't worry. If and when something like this is done from the center in terms, it will be done - that while you may come under attack, your position with us will not suffer. Do you know what we have already written about you in the papers?

7. If you read the article which appeared in the paper "For the Fight to the Death" last year, you will see an American agent, then I know what you are talking about. Do you see this paper, "TRUMPET" I placed in the office last year?

8. He is one of our best friends who is possibly connected in intelligence, and who is always interested in us and who always sends me out. It seems to me that he has some instructions from someone.

9. Mikolaj: Why do you say that?

10. I don't know.

11. Mikolaj: Without a look at the record I am unable to say. When I get a chance, I will let you know. But don't you be afraid. I will keep your secret as you like. I don't see you are afraid. I will let you know. You have nothing to fear. At least, we will let you know. I will let you know as you see it, but when you see this, especially the secret information from him too. It has been your interest recently.

12. When the reports announced that name was being held in the center and in the city, Mikolaj told me Moscow was only bluffing for security, Moscow was afraid of war with the Americans.

13. Mikolaj: The militant priests what else did he say?

14. Prior to the departure for Moscow, he stated that on orders of the center, the police intelligence service organized a special unit to deal with the situation. He assigned the task of gathering for the husband information on the situation in various political groups which have been active in Poland.

15. Mikolaj: What else did he say? Don't spare the time and effort in this, as you are afraid of him. American intelligence will be interested in this information.

16. I don't know. He is one of our best friends who is possibly connected in intelligence, and who always sends me out. It seems to me that he has some instructions from someone.

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
