1. The new  project cryptonym for AECAPELIN-1 has been assigned and has already been cabled to you. The new file number for the  will be 29-6-106. Future dispatches should be addressed to the attention of  , the Headquarters desk once officer handling the Paris operation.

2. **FOR MUNICH.** AECAPELIN-1's Salary Increase. In reply to Reference A, Munich Base was correct in paying AECAPELIN-1 \$200 per month since 1 August 1958. The Memorandum of Oral Agreement in lieu of contract prepared in March 1958 at Headquarters by the ARBATH field base officer,  (while on TDY) authorized payment of \$200 per month in the field. Since this MOA was approved by Headquarters at that time and subsequently has been extended until 11 March 1959, it will not be necessary to take any further administrative steps to allow AECAPELIN-1 to keep the over-payments. In spite of the fact that the past few project renewals erroneously requested only \$400 per month as AECAPELIN-1's field salary, sufficient funds were available each year under Project ARBATH to cover the additional payments made by Munich Base in accordance with the amount authorized under the MOA.

3. AECAPELIN-1/ARCAVATINA Relationship: A review of Headquarters ARBATH files failed to reveal any recent report which summarized AECAPELIN-1's operational relationship with the ARCAVATINAS. Therefore, it is difficult for Headquarters to comment on the advisability of AECAPELIN-1's accepting the ARCAVATINA-8 slot in Paris as requested in Para 5, Ref B. It would be appreciated if  could clarify the exact status of this relationship including answers to the following questions:

- a. Why has ARCAVATINA-12 provided it AECAPELIN-1 to the extent indicated in the latter's report?
- b. Has there been reciprocal action on AECAPELIN-1's part?
- c. What type of information, if any, has AECAPELIN-1 passed to ARCAVATINA-12 in the past?
- d. What remuneration has he been receiving from the ARCAVATINAS?
- e. What was AECAPELIN-1's exact role in the operational trips undertaken with ARCAVATINA-12 (e.g. Vienna in December 1958)?
- f. What would be AECAPELIN-1's duties or activities as the ARCAVATINA-8 representative in Paris?

As for Paragraph 5, Reference B, we have no information about any ARCAVATINA ties with OENWY. If such ties exist, please explain the exact status of these ties and the type of activity that ARCAVATINA men are allegedly performing for OENWY? How would ARCAVATINA-12's trip to PBRDMS consolidate this OENWY tie? If AECAPELIN-1 traveled to PBRDMS with ARCAVATINA-12, would this not endanger his Paris cover? What type of activities would ARCAVATINA-12 expect AECAPELIN-1 to perform in PBRDMS?

<p>4. <b>ABCAPELLIN-1/UPSWING Relationship:</b> Another aspect of Project AERATH that also needs further clarification is that of ABCAPELIN-1's operational relationship with UPSWING. Please summarize ABCAPELIN-1's relations with UPSWING for the past six months or a year including information on his UPSWING case officers and current KEI's. Has ABCAPELIN-1 informed his UPSWING case officer of his impending transfer to Paris? How has the matter of ABCAPELIN-1's termination of service for UPSWING been resolved?</p> <p>5. <b>FOR [ ] Cryptonyms and Boston Account:</b> In answer to Munich request in Paragraph 5, Reference C, we are herewith transmitting under separate cover and by split transmission as Attachment 1, a complete listing of the ABCASSOMAKIS, ANCAVATINA, ANKASPOKOS, ANKIBOSKIS, and miscellaneous other Munich personalities known to ABCAPELIN-1. Included as Attachment B to this dispatch is complete Headquarters breakdown of ABCAPELIN-1's escrow account including all deposits and withdrawals up to 31 March 1959. The escrow account total as of 31 March 1959 is \$7,445.05.</p> <p>6. <b>ABCAPELLIN-1 Archives:</b> In Paragraph 13 of the [ ] field project outline submitted as Attachment to Reference D, it states: "For security reasons, it is felt that the agent should not keep his archives, at least in bulky form, outside guarded premises. Accordingly, we intend to micro-film them and will provide him with a small viewer." How extensive are these archives and where will the originals be stored? What type of material do these archives contain? Can ABCAPELIN-1 retain a UNIKOP reproduction machine, microfilm and a viewer in his apartment without endangering his cover as a theology student?</p> <p>7. <b>ABCAPELLIN-1 Finances:</b> Paragraph 15 of the field project outline submitted in Reference D requests \$2,000.00 as a temporary raise to offset various losses incurred by ABCAPELIN-1's transfer? Will this amount be paid to ABCAPELIN-1 in a lump sum; on a monthly basis by field; or through Headquarters deposits to his escrow account. Please clarify.</p>
