SUBJECT: KOSAK, Wolodymyr Wolfgang Jaroslaw Otto  
alias KOSSAK, Wolodymyr

1. Reference is made to your SY memorandum IRP/Control No. Munich 19711, dated 8 June 1956, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office.

2. The files of this office reflect the following information concerning the subject of your request.

3. According to a report dated 18 October 1951 from a usually reliable source Subject worked closely with a friendly western intelligence service. Source claimed that he had supporting evidence (not disclosed in the report) which would substantiate his assertion.

4. A report dated 17 September 1955 from a source who was reported to be a Ukrainian emigre who was a Marxist, anti-American and had numerous Western, Soviet and Satellite intelligence contacts, indicated that Subject was accused of being employed by the Soviet Intelligence Service. This accusation has never been substantiated.

5. This office has numerous other traces on both Subject and spouse, dealing with their anti-Communist emigre activities and their UPA (Ukrainian Partisan Army) careers. There was nothing derogatory therein, of a substantial nature, although emigre political factions opposed to the faction to which they belong, have at times thrown about unsubstantiated rumours about both Subject and spouse.
