SILDE is presently a member of the Board of Directors of the Latvian Red Cross in Exile, Bad Canstatt, Stuttgart, Germany. NOTE: Only traces dated after July 1958--other than his involvement in <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> operation--are requested.</p> <p>c. <u>Julius BRACS</u> (aka Julius BRACS) DOB: 21 May 1909 POB: Latvia EMP: Subject was an historian, highschool teacher and editor-in-chief of <u>Latvijas Darba Kameras Ziņas</u> (Latvian Labor Union News) in independent Latvia. During the German occupation of Latvia in World War II, BRACS was in charge of a student group investigating NKVD (1940-1941) activities in Latvia. There is unconfirmed information that BRACS was an informer of the German Sicherheits Dienst. RES: BRACS is reportedly residing in Hanover, Germany. NOTE: Only traces dated after March 1958 are requested.</p> <p>2. <u>FRAN ONLY</u>: EGOA-14801, 20 June 1961, reflected Frankfurt Station traces on the above mentioned individuals.
