<p>REFERENCE</p> <p>EGW-13053, 19 September 1961</p> <p>1. On the basis of EGW-14233, 7 August 1961, and before receipt of reference, we had requested UPHILL traces on Subject, KWALINWIKIS, and KILM on the basis of "security interest" (because all three individuals are reportedly in close contact with MOG's agent [ ] UPHILL replied that they had no derogatory information on subject, and asked for details regarding the nature of our "security interest" in BRACS and KWALINWIKIS. Since we did not want to point a direct finger to [ ] by stating that both individuals are in contact with contacts of interest to us, we provided UPHILL with the following reply:</p> <p>"BRACS recently visited the United States and through his contact with various Latvian and Lithuanian emigre elements became of security interest to us."</p> <p>2. As for KWALINWIKIS, we never knew him or was of interest because he was in contact with an individual who is of operational interest to the American Agency.</p> <p>3. During our discussions with UPHILL on the two individuals mentioned informally that KWALINWIKIS is active with UPHILL and is being considered for employment by UPHILL, probably as an agent. Our FBI file on BRACS is far from complete, but we have seen a drafted agent card that Subject was formerly active. Although UPHILL has not directly asked us for traces on [ ] we have informally expressed an interest in him. Since this information is on off the record comment by a clerk in the UPHILL office, we see no need to forward UPHILL additional information.
