1. Headquarters files contain no additional information on:

2. Wilhelm HAHN (C) The carded reference shows one Willi Hahn, born 2 March 1905 as an SS Ustuf, Krim. Koms. in Stapo, Karlsruhe in December 1944. No additional information.

3. Heinrich HEIDERICH (C) The only possible trace is a carded reference showing one HEIDERICH, fnu (Kriminalpolizei), who was one of four KPD Police Officials in Berlin accused in April, 1946 of robbery and other crimes (Spandau). Communist. Fled before he could be apprehended. In June 1946 he was arrested while on a visit to a relative in the British Sector and found to be in possession of an official metal police badge stamped as follows: "Kriminalpolizei Brandenburg, Landrateamt Belzig, Nr. 1." Reemployed by Russians.

coordinating reference to a URBAN-KAHNEM-PROSSLICH Group, an intelligence group operating in Austria. The Rauter referred to here is further identified as an SS Captain in the SD who was liaison officer of Dept VI at "Army Group South" toward the end of the war.

S. Friedrich FRANK [] is mentioned in Attachment D to EKLA 55128, 18 June 1961, and in KUIC 16294, 23 July 1961, both in reference to the SJEDROWSKY case. CPlewing said FRANK had been recruited on SJEDROWSKY's recommendation in 1953, and further that FRANK was wanted by the Detet for atrocities committed during the war. We are enclosing as Attachment A an interrogation report on one Johannes HUNT, which contains detailed information on the activities in The Hague of one Friedrich FRANK, who might be identical with Subject. As you may note from EGLA 6335, 16 November 1953, our subject was detailed to ABBA during the war, served in CRAKOW, and later in The Hague. Appropriate portions of the Attachment may be passed to CATIDE, possibly through the CPlewing channel.
