1. Herewith photocopies of three reports written by KRICHBAUM (note: correct spelling; not KRIECHBAUM) to explain his connections with PONGER and/HOETTL. The first report, meitten dated 23 October 1952, was prepared at the request of ZIPPER headquarters after and "neglects" to mention that PONSER was present. HOETTL had mentioned his meeting with KRICHBAUM. A The second reppxrx report, dated 20 January 1953, was written after mmbxlmstlmmx MRICHBAUM read of the arrest of PONGER in the newspapers, represents the very first mention KRICHBAUM had ever made to ZIPPER of his contact with PONGER, and carefully avoius mentioning the fact that HOETTL was present at two of the meetings (August 1951 and October 1952). Unfortunately or KRICHBAUM, Realist minzdenbity Willi HOETTL dear old Willi HOETTL did montion KRICHBAUM's presence, in a masterful report Willi also felt constrained to prepare upon reading the newspapers, in which report Willi took pains to deflect attention to KRICHBAUM, Dr Waldemar MAE, Dr SCHAEFER of BV S, and varied others, where in the best "he went that way" tradition. Thereupon, KRICHBAUM was called to account by ZIPPER, and prepared the third report, dated 27 February 1953, which gives a most noncommittal account of the two PONGER/HUETTL/KRICHBAUM clambakes.

- 2. These three reports obviously seek to present KRICHBAUM in the best light possible and deprecate any significance which might be attached to his acquaintance with PONGER.
