1. Attached are copies of a dispatch from this office to G-2 Operations dated 13 March 1953 relating to information developed from the preliminary interrogation of WILLI HOETZL KRICHEBAUM (see ref A). This was passed after discussion and clearance with [ ] Koch [ ] and the undersigned expressed now dissatisfaction to G-2 Operations over Wolf Ringer's handling of the so-called HOETZL interrogation, and it is believed that G-2 is developing a firmer attitude toward HOETZL, though they have not as yet decided to arrest him.

2. Oddly enough, on 12 March during [ ] visit here, Wolf Ringer was meeting HOETZL for a social luncheon engagement in Frankfurt. No preliminary results of this meeting as we were informed verbally are that:

a. HOETZL requested from Ringer a 6-month entry visa for Germany (According to present reading there is no chance that G-2 will grant this and G-2 is in fact planning to place HOETZL temporarily on the G-2 blacklist pending investigation of allegations that he is a Soviet agent.)

b. Ringer procured from HOETZL what HOETZL purports to be his address book for comparison with the attachment to EASA-952. This is now being photostated and copies will be made available to addressees.

3. In reference to paragraph 6 of the attached, the undersigned was informed verbally by [ ] that HOETZL did write a letter to TIBER detailing his contacts with FUCHS and VIEBER. This letter according to [ ] information was undoubtedly passed through RUPERT KANDEL of TIB, and according to [ ] HOETZL put restrictions on the use of this letter by specifically instructing TIB that the letter was not to be shown to the Americans. This is at considerable variance with his statement to Ringer during the first interrogation that he would like the Americans to have this document. We think a letter from HOETZL to TIB authorizing them to turn over this document to the Americans might enable us to procure this epistle.
