1. In response to our questions concerning subject's current correspondence, ZIPPER informs us that subject is carrying on correspondence with Fr. fru GUENTHER who allegedly fled to West Berlin in January 1953. Fr. GUENTHER's father, former manager of the Bosch Dienst in Zittau, is now imprisoned in Bautzen. What disposition will be made of his case is unknown. Fr. GUENTHER has taken steps to assist her father, among them contacting KOU in Berlin.

2. Subject intends to establish herself as a refugee but declines any assistance such as a letter of recommendation fearing that some of her former coworkers in the Sov Zone who are apparently still active might somehow be compromised.

3. Subject is presumably unaware of the true nature of her brother's (a BRUDER) work for ZIPPER/SATURN. Because of ZIPPER's interest in her brother, they stand ready to assist subject after she achieves refugee status, should it prove necessary. Should she be assisted?

4. KUGO of SATURN staff mentioned recently that subject's former case officer, fru FRANK (phonetic) has returned to the USA. Could it be that Herr fru GUENTHER and fru FRANK are identical with the two persons mentioned in last para EGQA-9389.
