- 1. The police and neighborhood investigation resulted in the following:
  - a. Vital Statistics Points 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Subject's Form XX have been verified. Kennkarte No. WB 92347 was issued to Subject by police in PLOCHINGEN (official records 3-2).
  - b. Education Subject was a specially chosen hitler Jugend leader and was sent to a Hitler High School for special scudy. From there, Subject was given a certificate to matriculate to the University of Prague (official records B-2).
  - c. Employment Hecord Points 12, 1, and 14 of Form XX have been verified. (Official records B-2)
  - d. Military Career Subject joined the Waffen SS shortly after the war started, and served as an officer (official records B-2).
  - e. Political Attitude On the basis of the above information, it is understandable that Subject is regarded as a strong Nazi even today; however, there is nothing to indicate that Subject is active with the Neofascist movement (Political Police Opinion C-3).
  - f. Character Description Subject is reported to be very intelligent, proud, and a man with good character. He is well liked by all who come in contact with him, including a number of refugees. He leads a clean family life, is economical, andhas been described by many as a "true leader type".
  - g. Associates His closest friends are the proprietors of the ELASTON and Obb. HANDELS KONTOR G.M.B.H. firms, and a Mr. V. Jobst, a leading executive with the ELASTON Co.
