

Since he became a refugee in West Berlin, Subject has not been on good terms with his second wife. He has no contact with his first wife.

16. a. Christine Krueger. Female. Born 5 May 1932 at Rathen Kr. Pirna.
- b. Maria Krueger. Female. Born 13 March 1935 at Rathen.
- c. Bernd Krueger. Male. Born 16 February 1941 at Pirna.

The three above-named children are all Germans who are now living in Pirna-Neundorf, Cottaerstr. 3 (Saxony).

Christine is now studying chemistry at the local Hochschule. Marie and Bernd are still in school. All the children want to join their father in West Berlin and will do so as soon as he is able to support them.

17. a. Max Krueger. Born 1894 in Pirna. Works for the HO as a storekeeper living in Bastei near Pirna (exact address unknown).
- b. Otto Krueger. Born 1897. Present address unknown. Present occupation unknown. Is sickly.
- c. Elsa GLATTE, nee Krueger. Born 12 April 1913. Housewife living in Pirna. (Exact address unknown.)

Subject is not on good terms with either of his brothers as a result of a family disagreement about the disposition of their father's business after his death in 1932. Contrary to the father's will, Subject gave some of the money to the sister which angered the brothers, they claiming that she had no right to the inheritance. Subject says that because he had money he was able to buy out the business which the others could not do.

19. a. Subject presently possesses a West Berlin Behilfsmoessiger Personalausweis 156/67/53, issued by the Police President, West Berlin, on 10 April 1953.
- b. Driver's License, Class III, No. 6183/49, issued 6 August 1949 by the Police President, Pirna.

Subject's DDR identity documents, etc., were taken from him upon his arrival in West Berlin as a refugee.

20. Lutheran.

21. 1937-1945: NSDAF. Otherwise, none. Subject was declared "Unwuerdig" in 1940 because he did not take an active part in Party affairs. Subject claims he was forced to join the Party on pain of community economic and social suicide.

(Fachkurse Furgas-Wasser in Pirna, 1919)
24. German (native). Otherwise, none.
25. N.A.
26. Subject is a master plumber and plumbing installation engineer. (Subject is not a professional engineer; rather, he is a master craftsman.)
27. None.
28. Subject formerly owned his own business in Pirna. At the present time he is a refugee in West Berlin. Subject has no income.
29. Subject has been self-employed since 1932. However, in April 1952 and until 6 March 1953 (when he fled to West Berlin), Subject was employed by the DDR Minist. for Health as a consultant.
30. None.
31. There are many dwellers where Subject now lives. He knows none of them.
32. a. Dir. Fritz Dunker, Berlin/Lichterfelde, Limonenstr. 28. Age - 70/75. Presently a director of the Asphaltwerke.
b. Dipl. Ing. Konrad Spindler, Berlin-Charlottenburg, Kaiserdamm 16 III. Age 55. Presently employed by the Adairswerke.
c. Fritz Seiche, Munchen 38, Prinzenstr. 50. Age 46. Presently a bank director in Munich (name of bank unknown).
d. Jakob Kuhn, Kusel/Pfalz, Hintertorstr. 11. Age 48. Subject has a heating and plumbing business.
33. Subject is wanted by the DDR SSD. Subject's business was in Pirna and was nationalized after he fled to West Berlin on 6 March 1953. Subject fled because (a) he was being "watched by the SSD"; (b) because fnu WINKLER (born about 1915; married; one small child; 180 cm tall; thin, small face; thin hair), who was employed by Subject as his Kaufleiter was caught in Berlin on 26-27 February 1953 with a briefcase full of documents pertaining to shipbuilding in the DDR. Lived in Dresden/Zschachwitz; (c) because Subject of para 32-c above, who is a close friend of Subject, had been arrested

early in February 1953 and confined in Warnemuende. Whilst being transferred from Warnemuende to East Berlin, Seiche escaped. Coincidentally (according to Subject), Subject happened to be in Warnemuende and Berlin during this time. He was thus suspected of having assisted Seiche to escape to West Berlin.
