### Krupp Scion A Released PW

CAMP FELDHAUSEN, Germany, Oct. 8 (A.P.)—A son of the Krupp armament dynasty came back today from a prison camp in Russia, where two other sons died in fighting in the last war.

Dr. Dr. Harald Krupp von Buhlend and Hildegarde, 26, arrived at the West German frontier in a freight car packed with 25 other former inmates of a Grevenbrock labor camp.

His eldest brother, Alfred, 27, arrived here more than 2126-2646 years of confinement. Krupp industrial enterprises in 1941 after his war-crimes sentence was commuted. *(Microfilm)*
