MEMORANDUM FOR Chief, [redacted]  
SUBJECT: Paul [redacted]

The following information was provided by a confidential and reliable source who, however, cannot vouch for the accuracy of the information.

1. [redacted], a German SS officer stationed in Turkey during World War II, came to Turkey during the post-war years and made frequent contacts with the Turkish SS. In May 1957, he returned to Turkey on an official visit, aimed to establish <sup>German connections at</sup> contact with [redacted] and was received both by Prime Minister Adnan Menderes and the Turkish SS.

2. [redacted] was reported to be a very important official in the German SS, provided the Turkish army and equipment in return for full cooperation from the Turks and friends of Ankara in Turkey. [redacted] promised his complete cooperation, but he noted that the German SS would endeavor to do its best to create suspicion from the [redacted].
