SUBJECT: Krupp Reorganization.

Organizational changes in the firm of Friedrich KRUPP, Essen, are outlined in a recent issue of the Krupp Journal, house organ of the huge concern. The changes were actually effected when they were incorporated into the firm's organization handbook, effective January 1, 1958. The handbook is a Krupp tradition dating back to 1872, when the first handbook was issued by the great grandfather of the present owner, Alfried KRUPP VON BOMLEN UND HALBECK.

The changes appear to be designed primarily to relieve the top management of the company of any direct responsibility for the direction of commercial operations in order to allow them to concentrate entirely on policy matters and long-range planning.

The top executive board will now direct 20 of the 100-odd companies belonging to the Krupp interests. The remaining organizations will be controlled by these first 20 companies. The executive boards of the 20 companies are now empowered to control the subordinate enterprises directly, a feature of the plan which is expected to put a greater premium on initiative.

The new table of organization lists Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbeck at the top of the organization as owner, with Berthold KRUPP as his fully empowered agent. Under these two the members of the top management board are listed as: Dr. Hermann HORBOSCHER (administration), Dr. Hans KALLER (technical operations), Paul KILLER (sales), Johannes SCHROEDER (finance), and Dr. Paul HANSEN (deputy member).

The enclosure to this despatch is a list of the 20 controlling companies and the remaining Krupp-owned enterprises which are subordinated to these in the new scheme.
