**Krupp Will Build
Nuclear Plant**

DUESSELDORF, Germany, Feb. 7 (AP).—The Krupp Co. and the Brown and Boveri Co. of Switzerland will build the first German-constructed nuclear test power plant, a Krupp spokesman announced today. Construction of the plant, with a maximum capacity of 12 megawatts, is to be started this year.

Orders to build this power plant were given by 10 West German communities in order to test the possibilities of nuclear electric power.

The cost will amount to about \$10 million. Half the cost will be paid by the communities, half by the Federal Ministry of Atomic Research.
