14. CHARACTER - Subject's character, strengths and weaknesses, intelligence, loyalty, judgment, ability to communicate, leadership ability, and influence. Significance of individual in shaping international policies of his country.

Subject is a rather strong-minded person but not stubborn. He appears to be well-balanced and has no apparent weaknesses. He is of above average intelligence, is loyal, possesses sound judgment, and can effectively communicate, orally and in writing. His leadership ability is considered to be above average. He is not interested in politics and he will never occupy a position playing a significant part in shaping international policies of his country.

15. POLITICAL ORIENTATION - Attitude towards United States and other countries. Remarks and actions of subject toward representatives of the United States and its allies, and to representatives of nonaligned nations and Communist bloc nationals. Political activities and attitudes, important political contacts, party affiliations, potential political influence in country in the event of a change in government.

Subject can be considered as being pro-American. He has no political affiliation and is not active in politics. He accepts the present democratic form of government as best currently available. However, he would prefer an extreme rightist form of government.

She is not interest in politics. She is neat in appearance, has a deep voice, and is somewhat obese. She can be considered as being pro-American. Neither her nor her family has any influence on her husband's career.

Collector has known Subject since January 1965 and has social or professional contact with Subject approximately every two months. All information is based on collector's own observation.

Subject is an extrovert and he enjoys informal social activities. The best way to gain his confidence is to agree with his political views, have a few drinks with him, have a good sense of humor and, when it comes to business, be strong-minded and highly professional.

Subject is financially solvent. He has an excellent reputation within his organization. Collector considers him to be an highly competent operative.
