The lead was received from LLO/Bremerhaven (Iden 2. EGGA-5603, 23 Feb 72 who introduced Subject socially to [] in Hamburg on 16 November 1972. The LLO, who is leaving Germany PCS, and who has kept business and social contact with Subject over the past seven years, felt that Subject could be of more use to BKHERALD than to his own organization. Subject, who has been met bi-weekly since the introduction, has provided useful and interesting information [] and has expressed desire to work for BKHERALD "in any capacity, anywhere in the World." As an intelligence officer with twenty years of experience and with strong pro-WODUAL sympathies, we consider him a worth-while asset who could be directed against a number of targets in the [] Base area.
