d. Information dated August 1947 stated that Professor KUEPPMUELLER was an advisor to the Section for Research, Developments and Patents of the German Navy. He also headed the staff of scientific advisors to Admiral Domits. In the last two years of the war, KUEPPMUELLER and his several committees succeeded in developing the IXI and EXVI class submarines for large scale raids. He is now in Wolfenbuettel as head of a scientific staff of the German Mayy.
