- 1. KUHARA Rusanosukel is in close touch with Sergel La Tikhvinskiy, head of the Soviet Fishery Mission in Tokyo, 2
- 2. While the Chinese Communist sample fair was in Japan during 1955, KUMARA was active in contacting Government personnel to attempt to arrange for the Chinese Communists to extend their stay, as they wished to do. 3 KUHARA contacted, among others, Minister of International Trade and Industry ISHIBASHI Tanzan.
- KINARA received funds from the Chinese Communists both when Mas LI Te-chiup was in Japan in November 1954 and when the Chinese dramatic troups headed by MEI Lan-fang was in Japan in 1956.
- KIMARA is working for the unification of Communist and Nationalist China through NAYAMI Chikashige (2483/6015/6024/6650), a soldier of fortune (sie) who formerly lived in China through whom KUMARA is trying to strengthen his ties with CHIANG Ching-Ruo.
  - Field Company. The 87-year-old KUHARA is a semembat equivocal figure on the Japanese polysical scare, variously seported to be influential behind the political scenes and to be an escentric detard whose views are disregarded by political leaders. KUHARA headed the Setyukai before and during the war but has not returned to active postwar political life since his depurge. He is Chairman of the People's Council for the Restoration of Relations with Chine and the USSR (Nitchu Nieso Kokko Kaifuku Kommin Kaigi).
  - Source Compent. XUHARA has a more thorough knowledge of Soviet Far Eastern policy than anyone in the Japanese Government. KUHARA considers the Russiano as an Asiatit people andso mels close to them.
  - 3. Field Comment. KUHARA's efforts were apparently fruitless.
  - Source Congent. HAYAMT is a graduate of Kyoto University. During World War II he was persocuted by TOJO Hideki and went to China, where he was in charge of an operation designed to bring about peace between China and

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Japan; he was close to Prince KONOE Pumimaro.

5. Source Comment. According to informed sources close to Communist Chinese and Soviet circles in Tokyo, it is common knowledge that the Chinese Communists are working on CHIANG-Ching-kuo to bring about cooperation between Communist and Matfonalist China. It is believed that overtures to CHIANG are being made by reporters for the Chinese Communist newspapers Jon Min Jih Pag and Ta Kung Pag via Peiping and Hong Kong. Overtures are also being made to (K'UNG-Haiang-hai (1313/4382/3056) and En Hai-chan (7051/6932/1472).

Field Comment. The above Comment appeared in the same original report as the other information above, and no direct connection was indicated between the above approaches to CHIANG and the activities of KIRMRA. However, since the objective is the same and in both instances CHIANG is cited as the target of the approaches, it may be inferred that Source feels the two reported activities to be connected. Source also stated that KURARA was trying to strengthen his ties with CHIANG by working through HAYAMI and HSIEN Nan-kuang, a Chinese Communist official who defected from the Chinese Nationalist Embassy in Tokyo, but if there is any truth in the above it would appear logical that HSIEN would be using KURARA and HAYAMI as a channel to CHIANG rather than that KURARA would be trying to get to CHIANG through HSIEH.

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
