Dear Viktor,

I just sent you a letter and here I am writing you again. I am sending you a list of the members of the Preparatory Committee for the Organization of the Youth Festival. Several of the names included in the list below were given to you before:

- 1) ARTEAGA, Alberto; citizen of Venezuela, student; born on 11 May 1939 in Caracas (Venezuela). He arrived in Helsinki on 28 June 1961. Left for Moscow on 24 July 1961.
- 2) DALL'OGHIO, Marino; Italian citizen; engineer; born on 3 August 1924. Arrived in Helsinki on 23 July 1961. Left for Moscow on 24 July 1961.
- 3) DRAMALIEV (Drzmaliev), Lubomir K.; Bulgarian citizen; office employee; student; born on 8 September 1923, arrived in Helsinki on 17 February 1961. He traveled many times to Stockholm and back. He left for Moscow 23 July 1961.

4) GARCIA, Jean; French citizen; draftsman, born 29 June 1931, arrived in Helsinki 23 May 1961. He lives in Helsinki at Vihernisankatu 3.A.29.

5) JURI, Ciro; government [office] employee, Italian citizen, born 17 December 1925; arrived in Helsinki 29 June 1961. Lived at Kustaankatu 4a.B.23 (c/o Maria Sirenius). Flew to Moscow 24 July 1961.

6) QUARCOO, Benjamin; citizen of Ghana, government [office] worker, born in 1904. His wife Clara, born in 1910. He arrived in Helsinki on 16 February 1961. He flew to Stockholm 24 February 1961, and returned to Helsinki 11 July 1961. Flew to Moscow 24 July 1961.

7) RANDELER, Arpad; Hungarian citizen, student, born 23 February 1930. Applied for a visa in Prague on 5 August 1961 in order to participate in the work of the Committee for the Organization of the Festival. He has not yet arrived in Helsinki.

8) GUPTA, Sukumar, a citizen of India; teacher; born 11 May 1927 in India, lived in Calcutta. He received his passport, A 867163, issued 18 July 1961, in Calcutta, and arrived in Helsinki 15 August 1961. Lived in the Hotel Hansa. His visa is valid for 30 days. Arrived from Moscow. Flew to Moscow 18 August 1961.

9) HUSSAIN, Hourri Abdul Razzak; a citizen of Iran, student, born 21 August 1934 in Baghdad. Arrived in Helsinki 15 August 1961 from Moscow. Left for Moscow 18 August 1961.

10) SECK, Boubacar, a citizen of Senegal, press attache; born 4 April 1931 in Fodor, Senegal. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew back to Moscow 18 August 1961.

11) DOUKOURE, Wolibo; a citizen of Guinea, teacher, born 22 September 1936 in Dalaba (Guinea); arrived in Helsinki from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew to Paris 18 August 1961.

12) BATAKA, Alioune; a citizen of Mali, draftsman, born 20 January 1934. Applied to Moscow for a visa to participate in the preparation of the Festival. He received a visa for one week. He has not arrived yet.

13) VOLNES, Carlos Patricio; citizen of Chile, student, born 24 September 1938. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Stayed at the Hotel Hansa. Left Helsinki by plane for La Vega (via Stockholm) on 18 August 1961.

(14) de LIMA-SORRINHO, Antonio Estevan; a citizen of Brazil, born 21 July 1934. Lives in Rio de Janeiro. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. He left for Hamburg and other places, according to him to Brazil, 18 August 1961.

15) WEISSBACH, Rolf; a newspaperman, citizen of East Germany, born 6 September 1923 in Chemnitz, lives in Berlin-Baumschulenweg, Goldenhofer Ufer 10. Passport 679/61; issued 12 May 1961 in Berlin. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew to East Berlin 18 August 1961.

16) KONOVALOV, Boris; USSR citizen, engineer, born 16 January 1927 in Moscow Oblast. He applied for a visa to Finland for the period from 5 August 1961 to September 1962. The purpose of his trip: participation in the work of the Preparatory Committee for the Youth Festival in Helsinki. He has not arrived yet.

17) LIVENTSEV, Nikolay; USSR citizen, translator, born 9 August 1937 in Moscow, applied for a Finnish visa 15 August 1961 valid to September 1962. The purpose of the trip is the same as that of Konovalov. He has not arrived yet.

18) CHU, Liang, a citizen of China; born 24 February 1924. Resided in Peking; a chemist. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. He is staying at the Hotel Hospiz. He flew to Moscow 19 August 1961.

19) AL-SALHI, Dara Tawfik, a citizen of Iraq, engineer, born 2 April 1932 in Iraq. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew via Moscow to Iraq 18 August 1961.

20) JATTA, Jean; citizen of Senegal, a technician, born in 1937 in Paris. He was issued a visa for one month. Has not arrived yet.

21) BURELLI, Oskar; a student, citizen of Argentina, born 11 December 1931. Applied for a visa in Berlin, 1 August 1961. Has not arrived yet.

22) GOMEZ, Alfredo; a citizen of Mexico, born 14 February 1933. Applied for a visa to Finland in Hamburg on 12 August 1961. Has not arrived yet.

23) AMIN, Mohamed; a citizen of the United Arab Republic; born 26 December 1938 in Egypt. Applied for a visa in Hamburg on 12 August 1961. Has not yet arrived.

24) MEYER, Karl Fritz Otto; a citizen of Brazil, student, born 7 April 1932. Applied for a visa in Berlin on 1 August 1961. Has not arrived yet.

(25) BUSTOS, Esquerre, Luis Antonio; student, born 26 June 1939 in Colombia; a citizen of Colombia; lives in Bogota. He arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew to La Vega 18 August 1961.

(26) MAJEWSKI, Henri; a student, born 24 May 1932 in La Machine, lives in Paris 6^e, Rue des Ciseaux 8; he arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. He is staying at the Hotel [?]. He planned to fly to Paris 19 August 1961. His participation in the preparatory Committee for the Organization of the Festival has not been established yet.

(27) FALL, Aboime Badaro; a draftsman, citizen of Senegal, born 2 January 1934 in Senegal, lives in Dakar. Arrived from Moscow 15 August 1961. Flew back to Senegal 18 August 1961.

28) KOCH; I wrote to you about him and sent you his photo.

The following persons from among the participants of the Preparatory Committee are permanent members of the Committee remaining until the end of the Festival:

- 1) GARCIA, Jean (you received his photo)
- 2) GREGORI, Jeannine Laura; a French citizen, born in Paris 1 January 1938. Arrived in Helsinki 19 May 1961. Lives in Helsinki at Laivastokatu 12.B.41 (c/o Halonen). You will receive her photo.

- 3) DRAMALIEV, Lubomir K. (has not yet returned from Moscow).
- 4) KONOVALOV, Boris, has not arrived yet.
- 5) LIVEVISEV, Nikolay, has not arrived yet.

The Standing Preparatory Committee for the 8th Youth Festival of Peace and Friendship (that is its title) ended its two-day meeting in Helsinki on 18 August 1961. Forty persons (I mentioned the principal persons to you) from 24 countries participated in the meeting. The meeting fixed the period of the Festival from 27 July to 5 August 1962. It is assumed that 15-18,000 persons will participate in the Festival. The membership dues, the Festival program, and several other practical matters were decided upon. The meeting also decided to announce a contest for a Festival poster. At the meeting a message was read from 100 Finnish students who refused to participate. In this connection, it was decided to address an appeal to those Finnish youth organization which had refused to participate in the Festival. It was stated in this appeal that the Committee leaves the door open for all who want to participate in the Festival. The appeal also contains several practical suggestions how to organize joint work in one form or another with the youth organizations in Finland which had refused to participate in the Festival. The meeting also passed the text of a communique concerning the work of the standing committee and concerning preparations for the Festival. The Festival will take place not only in Helsinki,

but also in Turku, Tampere, Lahti, Tavastehus (Hämeenlinna), Hyvinkää, Riihimäki, Kotka, Björneborg (Pori), Borga [Porvoo], Rauma, Karkkila, and Karjaa. According to the program of the Festival, it is planned to hold an official opening ceremony at the Olympic Stadium in Helsinki on Saturday, 27 July, and the concluding ceremony will be held in Kaisaniemi on 5 August 1962. It is also planned to arrange visits to several firms, for example: the Glass Plant in Riihimäki; the Enso Gutzzeit Factory in Kotka; Werner Söderström Factory in Borga; and Rauma-Repola Plant in Rauma. This decision was adopted without asking the above-mentioned firms for their consent; and one may doubt whether they would give their consent.

That is all for the present. I hope that G... will be satisfied.

At your convenience, please confirm the receipt of my letter and Garcia's photo.

What do you think of the situation in Berlin, and what do people think over there? Do they believe there is a chance of war? Not officially of course, but according to rumors.

Greetings to Mr. G. and sincere greetings to Astrid.

I warmly press your hand.

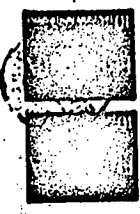

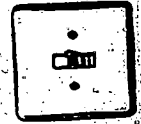
