OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

1. Operational Potential

Subject is being considered as an organizer of a credit organization or detective agency in West Berlin. This firm would be used to provide cover and documentation for a long-range Polish/Satellite surveillance team.

2. Operational Plans

Upon receipt of POA a case officer or principal agent will contact Subject. On the basis of a favorable assessment of Subject a recruitment attempt may be made. No CIA interest, operational requirements, or classified information will be disclosed to Subject.

3. Assessment

A Berlin principal agent, who knows Subject socially, recommends him highly for this activity. Sufficient information is not presently available to further assess him.

4. POA Request

It is requested that a POA be granted Subject for contact, assessment, and possible recruitment, as described above.
