A delegation of 18 members of the BDJ took part in a trip to Italy from 27 July to 9 August. Activities of the delegation included a banquet, and a private audience with the Pope. He spoke with each member personally and as a remembrance gave each of them a papal medallion. Foreign Minister deGasperi was presented with an album containing the most important publications of the BDJ.

Distribution of propaganda material by the BDJ during the reporting period included the following: 60,000 copies of "Information Service", 150,000 stickers, 350,000 leaflets, 20,000 pemphlets and 3,000 posters - a total of 883,000 items.
