1. Project CADOST was terminated on 29 December 1952. On that date we obtained a quitclaim signed by a member of the new Vorstand who had legal authority to represent and negotiate for the remaining members of that body. We then initiated action to dispose of Hallocks, who had been acting as cutout to the HDJ since his resignation as Chairman, which took place in October 1952.
2. It was agreed that, security-wise, it would be urgent to remove Hallocks from Germany as quickly as possible. Hallocks was instructed to apply for a United States visa (the only country he would consider emigrating to) and submitted his application prior to 31 December 1952. We did not attempt to dissuade Hallocks from emigrating to the United States, since it was the consensus of opinion that he could be best controlled there. However, we were informed by HARVARD that subject, due to his alleged KPD membership in 1946, alleged dealing in narcotics, and possible misuse of a Doctor title, has very little chance of obtaining a U.S. visa.
3. The only alternative to leaving Hallocks in Germany is to utilize the restricted U.S. immigration quota available to KUGGMN. Although subject may not qualify under the prescribed criteria established for this restricted quota, he is nevertheless a sensitive, high level agent, and it is quite feasible and probable that he may be of extensive future use to us in the psychological warfare field in the U.S.A. Also, he will be a constant source of concern to us while he remains in Germany. Although extremely intelligent and capable, subject at times shows questionable discretion -- at least from our standpoint. His penchant for journalistic expression would be something difficult to curb. He has already written several articles in prominent West German newspapers that were not in complete accordance with our views. It must be accepted as a fact that for months to come, Hallocks will be associated with the Americans.
4. We are presently maintaining limited personal contact with Hallocks, but will sever that contact as soon as the pending court action against the HDJ has been disposed of. After subject has received severance pay and has executed a quitclaim, we will turn him over to

a HARVARD Case Officer. We consider it urgent to remove Hallecks from Germany as quickly as possible after the court case has been settled. Therefore we recommend utilization of the special quota if our efforts toward normal immigration are abortive.
