1. ON SUNDAY MORNING [] BRIEF HOLLOCKS ALONG LINES
AGREED UPON DURING OUR TELECON.
2. HOLLOCKS INFORMED US THAT THERE COULD BE ANOTHER COURSE
OF ACTION DURING THE HEARING. THE HESSIAN PRE-TRIAL JUDGE,
SCHNEIDER, HAD CONTACTED H'S LAWYER ON 30 JAN. IN ORDER TO ASCERTAIN
IF OBJECTIONS TO PROCEDURE WOULD BE RAISED BY DEFENSE. H'S LAWYER
INFORMED JUDGE THAT OBJECTION WOULD BE MADE ON GROUNDS NON-
JURISDICTION HESSIAN COURT IN AS MUCH AS SAME CASE UNDER ACTIVE
INVESTIGATION BY KARLSRUHE ON FEDERAL LEVEL.
3. ON THE BASIS OF CONVERSATION MENTIONED ABOVE HOLLOCKS AND
PETERS LAWYERS PREPARED WRITTEN BRIEF TAKING EXCEPTION TO JURISDICTION
OF COURT RECOMMENDING THAT THE CASE IN ITS ENTIRETY BY TRANSFERRED
TO KARLSRUHE.
4. DURING FORMAL HEARING ON MONDAY THE PRE-TRIAL JUDGE
NOTED FORMALLY THE DEFENSE OBJECTION, HE ADVISED THAT THE MATTER
WOULD BE REFERRED FOR DECISION TO THE 3-JUDGE TRIAL COURT (STRAFKAMMER).
5. HOLLOCKS BELIEVES THAT THE TRIAL COURT'S DECISION WILL BE
FORTHCOMING FRIDAY 6 FEB. AND IS QUITE CERTAIN THAT THE CASE WILL
BE REFERRED TO KARLSRUHE.
6. IN INTERIM WE ARE CONTINUING OUR ATTEMPTS TO INDUCE KARL-
SRUHE TO PULL THE CASE UP ON FEDERAL LEVEL.
