BDJ

1. I am forwarding herewith two CIS intercepts dated 1 December 1952 from the BDJ office for East and Central Germany (in Berlin) to the Federal BDJ headquarters in Frankfurt. In one of the intercepts, Norbert Hammacher, the present head of the BDJ office in Berlin explains in detail the purpose and organization of the East Zone activity of the BDJ. In spite of the fact that Kollocks has been warned against the open mails the lesson does not seem to have been passed on to Hammacher. This is a particularly serious violation since he goes into considerable detail of the East Zone organization.

2. The other intercept is a letter from Hammacher to Gerhard Bischoff, who was the 1st chairman of the National Executive Committee at the time. According to the letter Hammacher has started legal proceedings against Arno Doerk, the former head of the Berlin branch of the BBF who was dismissed, to force Doerk to surrender some BDJ material to Hammacher. According to the letter Doerk is demanding that the BDJ pay his flight by air from Berlin to West Germany since it is too dangerous for him to travel through the Zone by train, before he surrenders the material. Hammacher, however, cannot go through with the court action since he hasn't the money. At the same time it should be noted that following our instruction, the East Zone BDJ and the regular BDJ have not been separated.

3. Since the date of these intercepts project has been terminated.
