GIS Intercepts/CADOST and the Apparat

1. I am forwarding herewith several GIS intercepts pertaining to the KMFRUDE and to the Apparat. These intercepts, particularly between Peters and his father indicate that Erhard Peter is somewhat unhappy with the Americans. They also indicate bad security since Hollocks discusses his meeting with case officers over the phone (giving the time but not the place).

2. Also enclosed is an intercept of a circular from the Bavarian branch to the local branches showing that they are following our instructions to clear up debts, etc. and that there are no security risks incident to our giving up our support of KMFRUDE.
