1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 4 February 1953 concerning []'s passport and recent developments in Germany concerning the BDJ.
2. Upon his return to the United States in September 1952, [] surrendered his passport to [] but we are unable to locate the passport at this time. At least, it is not in []'s possession. Mrs. Shipley, Chief, Passport Division, State Department, has been requested to place a stop on the issuance of any passport to [] on the basis that his travel overseas would not be in the best interests of the United States.
3. [] is calling at this office today and will be informed of the current developments in Germany reference the BDJ. At that time our instructions will be renewed that he is not to discuss his overseas activities with anyone, and any attempt by outside persons to query him are to be refused and the matter to be reported immediately to this office.
