SUBJECT

1. At a briefing on 29 January 1953, Mr. Dulles expressed the opinion that the subject's name should be placed on the visa check list of the State Department as an additional security precaution. Although we are aware that you have already taken a number of measures to prevent the subject's travel outside the continental United States, we believe that you may wish to act on Mr. Dulles' request.

2. We are also in receipt of information indicating that:

a. The subject's name may possibly receive additional publicity in connection with the present investigations involving the ban of the League of German Youth (LDJ) in Russia. While the nature of new disclosures during these investigations cannot be foreseen and may in fact be prevented, we believe that possibly some enterprising news correspondent may endeavor to contact the subject here in the United States.

b. The subject investigated the possibility of obtaining employment with another intelligence agency, specifically, ONI, before he returned to the U.S. At that time, he mentioned that he had had close liaison with ONI personnel in the Far East.

3. We realize, of course, that you have already issued instructions to the subject to cover such eventualities, but wish to keep you informed of present developments.

4. We would appreciate receiving confirmation of any action taken in response to Mr. Dulles' request.
