- 1. The German Mission has been informed by Dr. Otto John, Chief of the Federal Office for the Protection of the Gonstitution, that the League of German Touth (MDJ) was discussed at the 15 January conference of West German Land Interior Ministers. At this meeting, the Hessian Interior Minister, Heinrich Kinnkann, accused John's deputy of having instituted no action against the MDJ even though he knew of that organisation's illegal activities. Einn also chained that additional incriminating exists against the MDJ had been uncovered and offered to make it available to those Lend Governmentathat have not yet outlawed the organisation.
- 2. The Hessian Minister Freedant, Georg August Minn, also issued "gray" papers on the MDJ. (Other reports indicate that these papers were for internal distribution to the Land Interior Ministers only and are not the previously reported White Book on the MDJ, which Minn has threatened to issuel. Dr. John stated that his office was refused a copy of the papers. John also reported that he had asked the Deputy Federal SPD Chairman, Wilhelm McRies, Fropagenda Chief, Frits Medna, and Rescutive Committee Member, Walter Hengel, to use their influence to let the BDJ affair die a natural death, but he could not get definite assurance to that effect.
