

16. CADOST

This project was terminated as of 31 December 1952.

..... Since Hellocks apparently was no longer being trusted by all members of the new Executive Committee (Vorstand), and we had received various interpretations of what a fair settlement should be, we arranged to have a member of the new Vorstand obtain power of attorney to act for the entire Vorstand. The case officer after being satisfied that this power of attorney was properly notarized, and signed by all members of the Vorstand, a final settlement was made, and Wolfgang Knoll who had been chosen to represent the BDJ signed a "Quit claim". The claim specified that the BDJ would have no additional claims against the donors regardless what the future of the organization would be. Such a settlement enabled us to break off "clean" and quickly, and prevented special considerations for unpredicted ramifications, e.g., payment of salaries to BDJ functionaries in the event that the organization is disbanded.

Since we have now broken all official contact with the BDJ, (we have limited contact with Hellocks for disposal reasons only) CADRAMA has taken over the coverage and reporting on current BDJ activities.
