DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION:

Organization recently formed, presently has headquarters in Frankfurt. There are now 25 members, each with a record of high office in the FAU or the communist party, or MME SED. These communist defectors established the UFDJ with the assistance and guidance of the national executive of the BAU.

PURPOSE (INCLUDE P-RITHEIT FACTS AS TO MHY ASSET WAS DEVILOPED; INDICATE HOW IT IS USED):
The asset was developed to give ex-FDV members a vehicle to express their disillusion, and to penetrate and subvert active FDV units. The primary aim of the group is to unamsk the FDV as an instrument of the Kremiklin. To this end they have carried out poster, leaflet, and wall painting actions, disrupted FDV meetings, and concentrated on winning labor support.

EXTENT AND NATURE OF ASSET'S INFLUTNCE:

The Communist press has vehemently attacked the UFDJ as a new tool of the capitalists and imperialists.

DESCRIPTION OF COVER:

The UFDJ was founded by FDJ defectors who sought advice and support from the BDJ, an outspoken anti-Communist group. Control is maintained through the federal leadership of the BDJ who act in conformity with the guidance given the BDJ principal agent by the CLA sase officer.

SPECIFIC LIMITATIONS ON USE:

Since many of its members are ideologically in confusion, and sometimes have maintained a Marxian outlook, it is not anticipated that GIA will encourage the growth of the UFDJ to the size of a mass movement, rather it will be maintained as an elite political warfare arm directed almost entirely at the FDJ and factory workers.

FOR MINT ADDITIONAL PURPOSES COULD ASSET BE USED? EXPLAIN:

Since the UFDJ is carrying out an extensive program at present it is doubtful whether or not it could undertake any more activity without an increase in personnel and financial support.

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES:

The WKS now has 450 mambers organized in 89 cities and towns in all of the Laender of the East German State. In addition there are eight covert psychological warfare cells capable of producing material inside the German Democratic Republic.

DESCRIPTION OF OUTPUT:

For the most part output has been confined to materials (posters, leaflets, stickers) produced in West Germany by the BDJ and distributed in turn by the WES. This distribution produced in west dermany by the BMS and distributed in turn by the WAS. This distribution has run from 7,000 - 10,000 items per month. The WKS has contacts in the Volkspolized and the FMS who can and have in the past supplied information which the BMS has exploited fixeex for propaganda purposes. WKS files contain the addresses of 15,000 potential contacts. These persons are supplied with WKS material as often as possible.

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF AUDIENCE:

Content is anti-communist, attempts to encourage and promote a spirit of resistance to the Soviet sponsored East Serman regime.

CESCRETION OF MARKER AND EXTENT OF CIA CONTROL OF INFLUENCE:
GIA control is maintained through briefins of the principal agent of the BDJ, who in turn passes down guidance and financial support to the leadership of the WKS through the executive committee of the BDJ.

Since a line must pass through at least one, and more often than not two intermediaries it would seem to require at least one week from the time the case officer handed down a line until it appeared in the output of distribution of a WKS item.

The WKS is limited by the security measures imposed in the East German state, and the stringent border measures which impede the flow of western produced material to the WKS distribution system.

The WKS was developed in order to channel the anti-Communist sentiments of East German

youth, and to keep alive the spirit of resistance to the Soviets in that area, thus assuring the populace that they are not forgotten by the West.

EXPTIT AID HATERE OF ASSET'S THE LUTICE: Since the target of this group is the East German populace it is almost impossible to judge the effect of WKS produced and distributed material. The mure fact that there is such an organization, and that it was capable of distributing some 20,000 pieces of propaganda in Mast Germany during a three month period must be regarded as some measure of its effectiveness.

OCCUPACE OF COVER: In East Germany the organization is strictly covert.

THE HOW ARE IT UND DEVELOPED):

CIA control is maintained though briefings of the principal agent of the BDJ, who in turn passes down guidance and financial support to the leadership of the WKS through the executive committee of the BDJ. The asset was developed through the efforts of contacts of the principal agent of the BDJ, and forms the East German division of the overt organisation.

CHECCPIC LAMITATIONS ON USE:

The activities of the WKS are limited by the security controls of the East German state, and the knowledge that compromise could mean long imprisonment to its members, The increased severity of border controls will increase the problem of distributing West German-produced propaganda make materials in East Germany by the WKS.

KON HAT PRINCIPAL PURPOSES COUID ASSET BE USED? PROPERTY.

The WKS might be able to provide a manpower pool for the recruitment of reliable paramilitary personnel, or agents for positive intelligence gathering purposes.

HTHE Bund Deutscher Jugend (League of German Youth) (BDJ)

DISCRUPTION AND INCATION: The BM is a mass youth organization with 11,200 member in 10 West German Laender and West Berlin. The organization is outwpokenly anti-Communist, has recently taken a strong stand against radicals of the right, and in general endorses a supra-party program designed to appeal to a wide group of young Germans. In the German Democratic Republic the BDJ isknown as the Widerstandskreise der Deutschen Jugend in der Sowjetsone (Resistance Circles of German Youth in the Soviet Zone) (WKS). The executive committee of the BDJ also controls the program and activity of the anti-Communist splinter Unabhaengige Freie Deutsche Jugend (Independent Free German Youth (UFDJ).

THE BIN was developed in order to afford GIA a strong political warfers arm, and to serve as a pool for the recruitment of para-military personnel. Theorganisation is used to hold rallies, assemblies, andpublic meetings in support of U.S. policy aims. Poster actions, pamphlets, & leaflets are produced and distributed towards the same end.

DIFFIT AID NATURE OF ASSET'S KINDLUNION: Letters and official encouragement from the Bonn government and favorable west German press coverage indicate the BDJ is winning acceptance from those quarters. The communist press issues a continuing stram of invective against the BDJ while the communist youth group, the FDJ, has spared no effort to frustrate the program of the BDJ.

DESCRIPTION OF COVERS

Since the BU is an overt youth organization it requires no special cover. Ostensibly funds are derived from organizational dues, and anti-Communist West German industrialists. The case officer poses as the spokesman for a private international organisation supported by private sources in the United States. As a matter of record the Communist press has charged that the BBJ is supported by Rhenisch industrialists.

Uniting AS TO U.S. A.D CIA THE REST? HUDICATH UNE, HE HEAT MAY, AND TO THAT HATHER. The principal agent realises there is American interest in the BDV, and he may suspect by now that it is official in character, buthe cannot prove this. The principal agent is the sole link between DIA and the BDJ.

DESCRIPTION OF MAINTER AND EXPLIT OF CLA CONTROL OR MUTLUMNED (INCLUDE PURTINGE PACTS AS TO HOW ASSER WAS DEVELOPED):

CIA exercises financial control of the organization through the case officer. The principal agent volutarily seeks ideological and policy guidance, and has followed the suggestions of his CIA case officer. The principal agent was the founder of the organization, and MAM has been subject to CIA control since the inception of the organisation almost two years ago.

SPICKETC LIGHTATIONS ON USE:
In response to CIA directives the BDJ has taken an uncompromising stand in favor of European unity, West German participation in the EDC, and in general the program of yhe present West German government. This positive stand has alienated the Socialists who refuse to cooperate with the BDJ in the struggle against wommnism.

CR WHAT ADDITIONAL PURPOSES COULD ASSET BY OS DY REPLAIN.

The BDV carries out a full and active program. It is doubtful whether or not they could be utilized for any additional CIA purposes without revealing the interest of the United States.

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
