Basic Papers - The APPARAT - 24 Sept 1951

31 Aug 50 Plan - 3000 in retardation  
4000 for general resistance  
Complete separation of APPARAT and BDJ.  
Only connection with BDJ - Pash and Hallochs.

11 May 50 Field decided to reorganize APPARAT.  
A group - rail and commo interdiction - expendable.  
B group - (1) fighting force  
(2) sabotage - 50 persons

30 June 51 Strength and disposition  
W zone fighting men  
W zone leaders  
E zone fighting men  
E zone individual workers

14 Jul 51 ? All recruiting for PM activities (except specialist) was stopped  
on orders of [ ] due to danger of compromise.  
(Personnel - Hallochs chose Pash to head the APPARAT)- Pash picks  
regional chiefs and deputies.  
Field requested case officer for APPARAT be in field by 20 Oct 50.  
Hdqs. notified field 30 Nov that person being sought. [ ] arrived  
in field Feb 51.

9 Jun 51 First training cycle started.  
Course (6 days) consisted mostly of weapon instruction. Incomplete  
due to lack of sabotage supplies and commo deficiencies.  
Two week training period contemplated.

14 Jul 51 [ ] instructed to break off all PM training and stop recruiting for  
APPARAT due to danger of compromise.  
Security - All prospective members of APPARAT cleared by Chief and  
Asst. Chief, then they are given questionnaire. Completed question-  
naire given to Pash who checks BDJ files and blacklists. Pash gives  
them to [ ] who passes them to [ ] for BGHABIT, QKFLIGHT and  
HTCURIO clearance. [ ], Asst. Chief, responsible for internal  
security. Checks with BDJ members from same area and clears prospec-  
tive members as completely as possible.

1 Jun 51 Otto Kruggel was arrested in Soviet zone. (BDJ leader of Mogdeburg-Halle)  
He knew Hollochs, Pash, two leaders E. Zone Apparat "as well as plans for the Apparat."

✓ Due to danger compromise field received orders to overhaul security system of Apparat - "which at the time of this report (24 Sept 51) is still in progress."

? Cover - Army cover for indigenous personnel training at Grafenwohr.  
□ □ is in Germany under commercial cover - ostensibly as a business man and presented to his instructors as a weapons collector and technician.

? Communications - 4 couriers in Soviet Zone and Safehouse mentioned by Charlotte Schonoff - chief of Soviet Zone net.

Radio net progress - Several instructors have been named.

? Commo in case of Soviet occupation - rubber boat teams established - 15 head men for 15 different points have been recruited.

Caching supplies - Progress report in 20 July 1951 says □ □ feels there is only one region in Germany where large stocks of supplies can be dispersed in caches secure from discovery, easily protected "etc."  
"Here □ □ plans to cache supplies for long term" etc.
