1. This memorandum is written to confirm a conversation between [] of your office and [] of FE/3/FI concerning [] .
2. To the best of my recollection no member of EE Division approached me with reference to the previous employment by FE Division of Subject during the period November 1950 to February 1951. As a matter of fact, I did not know Subject was still employed by the Agency until I was approached for his files by [] of EE Division about three or four weeks ago.
3. My only recollection of discussions as to the future employment of Subject, after his release by FE Division, were with Personnel Division concerning his potential usefulness to any office of the Agency where his technical knowledge would be of value. At that time, insofar as I can remember, the matter of his being considered poorly fitted for employment as an IO/OPS was made entirely clear, but that his knowledge of weapons should be valuable to any office requiring an individual with that particular training. This matter was also discussed with [] who was then in charge of an office dealing in Procurement and Supply, where I believe Subject was employed after his release by FE.
4. In order to refresh my memory concerning any action taken by FE Division with regard to Subject, and in order to be certain that I had knowledge of any action taken by any other members of FE Division, I contacted [] , presently with RQM/RC, who was at the time of Subject's employment and release, in charge of the Southeast Asia Section of FE Division. [] 's recollection of these matters was substantially in agreement with mine. He stated that he was quite sure that no one from EE Division had ever contacted him concerning Subject's employment. He had not known that Subject was employed by EE until I so informed him.
5. [] said that he remembers discussing Subject's past service for FE Division, and the difficulties Subject had had in the field, in some detail with someone in Personnel Division (possibly either [] or []) at the time FE released Subject. He stated that he also discussed Subject's employment record and his various talents with [] , mentioned in Paragraph 3 above.
6. The FE files on Subject (contained in Project ATLAS) have been in my charge since the time of Subject's employment and, so far as I can remember, they have never been requested by any other division in the Agency, nor
