ANNA POHLOD. Subject's last foreign residence was Munich, Germany, and he immigrated to the United States from Bremen, Germany. He traveled on an Immigration Visa and was examined by United States immigration officers at New York, New York. Subject gave the name of MICHOLAST LEBED, 107 Havanayar Street, Brocklyn 11, New York, as the "person he was coming to." On his immigration to the United States, subject was accompanied by his wife, Olda Darla TURAN; his daughter, ZORIAMA TURAN; and his mother-in-lew, ALEXAHDRA DUMYN. Subject gave his occupation as Journalist and indicated that he married Olda. Darla TURAN on March 19, 1936 at Lwow, Ukrains. She was born October 23, 1912 at Sokal, Ukrains. His daughter, ZURIANA TURAN, was born September 22, 1942 at Lwow, Ukrains.

The Immigration and Maturalisation Service records further reflected that by letter dated March 8, 1950 subject advised that his correct name was NYKOLA EXERD.

Subject filed a declaration of intention to become a United States citizen #615863 on Merch 17, 1950 in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

She indicated that her internment in a concentration camp was for political reasons, and indicated that "within the past five years she had not been affiliated with or active in organizations devoted in whole or part to influencing or furthering in the United States the political activities, public relations or public policy of any other government."
