<p>REPORT from BUENOS AIRES</p> <p>SOURCE: One who is closely connected with the Argentine police.</p> <p>The following excerpt is taken verbatim from the above referenced document:</p> <p>The German Officer Junta in Argentina has been working underground to build up a German unit of all branches for service in the Egyptian Army. This is apparently part of a widespread organization to bring German officers and soldiers back into service. The Junta is in touch with the Egyptian Embassy in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Following are "Who's Who" notes on some of the leaders:</p> <p>....</p> <p>c. <u>Johann Von LEERS</u>, Nazi writer, now living in Buenos Aires, Argentina under an alias. Until 1928 an attache at Wilhelmstrasse. Then forced to leave because of Nazi activity. After Hitler came to power, became "Reichschulungleiter des National-sozialistischen Studentenbundes." Later he became a newspaperman and was chief editor of the periodical "Unser Wille und Unser Weg," also Berlin editor of "Nationalsozialistische Rheinfront." He has also written numerous books, among which are "Vierzehn Jahre Judenrepublik Weimar," "Geschichte des Nationalsozialismus," and "Adolf Hitler." These made him a leader in Nazi literature.</p> <p>....</p>
