Appraisal of Content: 2.

In Sept 1956, the Arab League advisor on German matters, (Prof. Dr.)  
John Leers of Cairo-Madi, No. 21, Rue 83, sent a circular letter  
of his contacts in West Germany. In this letter, Leers stated  
Pirate Club of British Prime Minister (Sir) Anthony Eden is  
in forcing the Suez Canal Users Association to declare war,  
good possibility that West Germany will be immediately occupied  
forces. Leers points out that the Germans, at the moment,  
absolutely no desire to engage in war, but they do not intend to  
let the British start shooting over this issue. Since the West  
German government joined the Pirate Club, they must now reckon with the  
imminent occupation of West Germany in the event of war in the Suez  
Canal region.
