SUBJECT - Recent Activities of Prof. Dr. Hermann Wirth

The following information was obtained from [ ] by the undersigned on 17 January 1937.

REPORT

1. Professor Hermann Wirth, Gerichtstrasse 9, Marburg/Lahn, is known for his historical "research" in the field of religions, particularly those of the "atlantic-nordic" race. Wirth's writings have for years been distributed by the Secretary General of the Austrian Social Movement, (Oesterreichische Soziale Bewegung), Wilhelm Landig, Vienna.
2. The University of Marburg has recently attacked and criticized Wirth for his "scientific" views. This attack has prompted Wirth to become more active than before and seek additional supporters for his ideas. He has already been partially successful in this effort in that the Ludendorff Organization, until now not a supporter of Wirth's, has approached Wirth and promised to back him.
3. Wirth plans to use his contacts in Flemish circles (which date back to 1914-1918) to interest them in Landig's and Karl Heinz Priester's planned "Germanic Bloc" and win for this bloc Flemish supporters and backers.
4. Wirth is in constant contact with Johannes Von Leers, presently residing in Cairo. Leer's wife was in 1939 the founder of the first Hermann-Wirth-Society in Berlin.
