Dr. Johannes von Leers

- Lears, living in Cairo, proposed to the head of the German Social Hovement (Deutsche Soziale Bewegung), Karl Heinz Priester, that he move to Cairo and publish a newspaper in German for Germa: residents of the Arab states. Lears indicated that necessary funds and suitable housing for this venture would be provided by to Information Office of the Arab League. Priester declined the offer. Lears also asked him to prepare an article for publication in all the countries that were represented at the Bendung Conference requesting them to declare Germany a solumial area.
 - lears is planning to organize a "Hational Aid" society to make economic provision for members of mationalist groups imprisoned by court orders or presented for their beliefs. He presented a proposal on this line to Himbans von Rychkowsky, Frankfurt/Main-Hisderred, publisher of The Bridge (Die Brusche), with whom he has been in correspondence.
- Loers believes that Ernst von Kayser, a German who arrived in Cairo in fall 1937, is an "agent" and has therefore out off all contact with him.
