

Dr. Johannes von Leers

6. Leers, living in Cairo, proposed to the head of the German Social Movement (Deutsche Soziale Bewegung), Karl Heinz Priester, that he move to Cairo and publish a newspaper in German for German residents of the Arab states. Leers indicated that necessary funds and suitable housing for this venture would be provided by the Information Office of the Arab League. Priester declined the offer. Leers also asked him to prepare an article for publication in all the countries that were represented at the Bandung Conference requesting them to declare Germany a colonial area.
7. Leers is planning to organize a "National Aid" society to make economic provision for members of nationalist groups imprisoned by court orders or prosecuted for their beliefs. He presented a proposal on this line to Nikolaus von Rychkowsky, Frankfurt/Main-Giesderrad, publisher of The Bridge (Die Bruecke), with whom he has been in correspondence.
8. Leers believes that Ernst von Kayser, a German who arrived in Cairo in fall 1957, is an "agent" and has therefore cut off all contact with him.
