- 1. Certificate of wirth, issued by Estonian Minister to Sweden, on 2 Dec 1955, indicates that SUBJET was born en 8 Nov 1910, at Imavere, Pilistvere Commune, Estonia.
- 2. The Certificate of Sirth referred to in paragraph one indicates that SUSJECT is the son of Tonistels and Maddens Meis, neededbauer.
- 3. The Parriage Certificate, issued by Fresta Parish, Swedish State Church, Stockholm, Sweden, indicates that SUBJUT narried Oilme Raidvee, new Orb, on 26 Aug 1950. SWEJEST adopted his wife's two children by a former marriage.
- 4. TUNDECT is Stateless Setonian. Swedish Alien Passport #23238, issued by the Spedish State Alien Supervisory Consission, on 7 Dec 1955, valid until 13 June 1959, verifies SUBJECT's Estonian nationality. Estonian Passport #598074, issued by the Police Consissioner in Poltsamas District, Estonia, on 3 Nov 1927, further confirms SUBJECT's Estonian nationality.
- 5. According to SUBJUT's statements, both his parents and two sisters and a brother Heino Yeis, Hilda Ye's and Helmi Kolk all resided in Imavere Pilistvere Commune, Estonia, in 1944. SUBJUCT has had no contact with them since that time and loss not know their present status or wherezbouts.
- 6. According to SCHECT's statements, he presently resides at Cotgrand 6, Upplands Vasby, Sweden, and was a resident of Sweden on 7 Aug 1953. Previous residences given were as follows:

- 7. No physical or mental defects were revealed during the course of the investigation,
- 8. According to UUSGECT's statements and a Hilitary Service Certificate, issued by the former Estenian Minister to Sweden, H. Laretei, on 2 Dec 1955, SUBJECT served in the 5th Estenian Artillery Group from 25 July 1931 to 1 Aug 1932. He graduated from the estenian Army Officers School at Tondi, datonia, on 24 Feb 1933 as a reserve 2nd It. in Mar 1944, he was called to active duty and derived as a 2nd it. with the lit Artillery Revinent of the Estenian Division (35) of the German Army until 17 Sep 1944, when busdleft's unit was trapped by the Russians and SUBJECT fled to Farnu, Estenia.
- 9. SUBJECT stated that he has never been politically active, but he woted twice in pre-communist Satonia -- once for Pats, who was the Agrarian Party candidate, and once for the Satonian Farmers' Party. SUBJECT claimed to be anti-communist and opposed to socialism and totalitarismism.

10. SUBJECT stated that in 1739 and 1940 he was a member and a 2nd Lt. of the metonian IIvil Pefense "Maitselut" (Artillery) at Parmu, Matonia. From 1933 to 1935 he was a member and a 2nd Lt. in the cavalry of the Satonian Givil Defense at Imavere, Satonia. From 1938 to 1940 he was a member of the male choir "Parmu beskor" at Parmu stonia. He was a member of the Islanian Reserve Officers Association from 1932 to 1940. From 1940 to 1941 he was an involuntary member of the Estonian Commercial Worker Trade Union (a communist originization) carring the Russian occupation of Estonia. Sing 1946 he has been a member of the Evenska hetalliminatriarbetareforbundet (Swedish Fetal acrkers' Trade Union) at Upplands - Vasby, Swedan.

I). Additional stated that he mas never been arrested for any crime by the police of any country.

A certificate, issued by H. Laretei, former Estonian Hinister to Sweden, reflects that BUSLOW was never convicted of any crime in Estonia.

The Board of risons, Stockholm, Sweden, reported that SUSJECT was never convicted of a crime nor imprisoned in Sweden.

- 12. According to BUBLET's statements, he completed his schooling in Estonia and has the equivalent of an American secondary school education. SUBJECT passed the literacy test administered during the RRP interview.
- 13. According to SUNJUCT's statements, he has been employed as a metalworker from April 1946 to the present date at A/B Uptimus, Upplands Vabby, Sweden.
- 14. On 9 Apr 1956, the Amedian State Alien Supervisory Commission reported that it was prepared to Isaue a Sertificate of Readdission to SUSJECT, as he had not eigenpresented any material facts on his preliminary questionnaire for use in connection with application for a visa under the provisions of the Refugee Selief Act of 1953.

On 19 and 20 har 1956, the following named persons were interviewed at the American Labassy, Stockholm, Sweden, concerning SUBJEST and family:

Villivalusar, clark, corn on 5 Aug 1925, at Voisiku, Viljandi, Estoria, restding at Tentralvagen 3c, Upplands - Vasby, Sweden, has known Ubuscot ten years and his wife six years as a friend and nocial acquaintance.

Silla Soosalu, clerk, born on 3 June 1918, in Farmu, Estonia, residing at magensystem 27, Stockholm, Sweden, has known SULDENT ten years and his wife 30 years as a friend and social acquaintance.

Ivapo nulson, student, born on 26 May 1922, in Tallinu, datomia, residing at duethellarevagen 13, kotebro, Sweden, has known 305050T and his family five years as a friend and social acquaintance.

These persons stated substantially that SUBJECT and his family are trust-worthy, responsible, sober people. SUBJECT is honest, reliable and a good worker. They have good morals and enjoy good health. SUBJECT is anti-communist and his family and he are opposed to totalitarian forms of government. SUBJECT and his family were recommended as good, prospective American citizens. Nothing derogatory was known about SUBJECT and/or his family.

15. North OT was interviewed at the NEC Office, American Embassy, Stockholm, Sweden on 28 Feb 1956. He made the same statements orally about his life, as he had previously written on his preliminary questionnaire. SUBJECT appears mentally alartened physically acceptable and made a good impression upon the interviewer.
