REPORT ORIGIN (NAME AND ADDRESS)

DETAILS

1. Certificate of Birth, issued by H. Larstei, former Estonian Minister to Sweden, on 2 Dec 1951, indicates that SUBJECT was born on 20 Apr 1922 at Are, Estonia.

2. The Certificate of Birth referred to in paragraph one indicates that SUBJECT is the daughter of Otto Orb and Ann Orb, nee Juhkam.

3. The Marriage Certificate, issued by Presta Parish, Swedish State Church, Stockholm, Sweden, indicates that SUBJECT married Hans Leis on 26 Aug 1950. SUBJECT stated she was formerly married to Arvo Laidvee, who was drowned on 4 July 1949. She had two children by her first husband who have been adopted by her present husband.

4. SUBJECT is stateless - Estonian. Swedish Alien Passport #23237, issued by the Swedish State Alien Supervisory Commission, on 6 Dec 1955, valid until 6 Dec 1957, verifies SUBJECT's Estonian nationality.

5. According to SUBJECT's statements, her mother and sister, Leida Orb, were residing in Are, Estonia, in 1944. SUBJECT has had no contact with them since that date and does not know their present status or whereabouts.

6. According to SUBJECT's statements, she presently resides at Gotgrand 6, Upplands-Vasby, Sweden, and was a resident of Sweden on 7 Aug 1953. Previous residences given were as follows:

7. No physical or mental defects were revealed during the course of the investigation.

8. According to SUBJECT's statements, she has never had any military service.

9. SUBJECT stated that she was forced to vote for the communists by the Russian occupation authorities in Estonia in 1941. She stated that she has never been politically active but that she is opposed to communism and favors a conservative democratic type of government.

10. According to SUBJECT's statements, she has belonged to the Swedish Charwomen's Union at Upplands-Vasby, Sweden, since 1955; the Svenska Metallindustriarbetareförbundet (Swedish Metal Workers' Union) at Upplands-Vasby since 1953; and was a member of the Swedish Industrial Rubber Workers' Union at Gislaved, Sweden, in 1945 and 1946.

11. SUBJECT stated that she has never been arrested for any crime by the police of any country.

A certificate, issued by H. Larstei, former Estonian Minister to Sweden, reflects that SUBJECT was never convicted of any crime in Estonia.

DETAILS:

The Board of Prisons, Stockholm, Sweden, reported that SUBJECT was never convicted of a crime nor imprisoned in Sweden.

12. According to SUBJECT's statements, she completed her schooling in Estonia and has the equivalent of an American elementary school education. SUBJECT passed the literacy test administered during the IRP interview.

13. According to SUBJECT's statements, she is a housewife.

14. On 9 Apr 1956, the Swedish State Alien Supervisory Commission reported that it was prepared to issue a Certificate of Readmission to SUBJECT, as she had not misrepresented any material facts on her preliminary questionnaire for use in connection with application for a visa under the provisions of the Refugee Relief Act of 1953.

On 19 and 20 Mar 1956, the following named persons were interviewed at the American Embassy, Stockholm, Sweden, concerning SUBJECT and family:

Vilja Palusaar, clerk, born on 6 Aug 1925, at Voisiku, Viljandi, Estonia, residing at Centralvagen 3c, Upplands-Vasby, Sweden, has known SUBJECT six years and her husband ten years as a friend and social acquaintance.

Elle Soosalu, clerk, born on 3 June 1918, in Parnu, Estonia, residing at baggensgatan 27, Stockholm, Sweden, has known SUBJECT 30 years and her husband ten years as a friend and social acquaintance.

Ivar Paulson, student, born on 26 May 1922, in Tallinn, Estonia, residing at RUSTHALLAREVAGEN 13, Rotebro, Sweden, has known SUBJECT and her family five years as a friend and social acquaintance.

These persons stated substantially that SUBJECT and her family are trustworthy, responsible, sober people. They have good morals and enjoy good health. SUBJECT is anti-communist and is opposed to totalitarian forms of government. SUBJECT and her family were recommended as good, prospective American citizens. Nothing derogatory was known about SUBJECT and/or her family.

15. SUBJECT was interviewed at the IRP Office, American Embassy, Stockholm, Sweden on 28 Feb 1956. She made the same statements orally about her life, as she had previously written on her preliminary questionnaire. SUBJECT appears mentally alert and physically acceptable and made a good impression upon the interviewer.
