Het only did he supply vast named of detailed information and focusenests upon arrival in the United States but for over two years, prior to his defection, he supplied information and documents of vital importance to this country. His services have restortably abled this Agency and he has rendered valuable assistance to the Pederal Bureau of investigation. 
