1. Reference is made to the name check request from Immigration and Naturalization Service for information concerning Georg v. LILLENFELD, file No. V-1354409, born 27 November 1912, who entered the United States on 30 October 1952.

2. The files of this office contain the following information concerning the subject of the inquiry.

3. A report dated 10 July 1945 from the Counter Intelligence Corps, Marnaid Detachment, APO 464, referred to one Georg LILLENFELD, born 27 November 1912 at Riga, Latvia, a/ having been arrested by American Counter Intelligence agents on 10 July 1945 at his home at Brunnenplatz 1-4, Merano, Italy. The arrest was based upon information that Subject had been the head of the civilian section of the German Radio Propaganda in Fasano, Italy. According to an interrogation report of one Karl GONNEL, who was Director of the Italian propaganda radio program "Jerry's Front" at Fimo, Italy, LILLENFELD was a second lieutenant in the German Schütstaffel (Elite Guard - SS). LILLENFELD, under questioning, reportedly denied the latter accusation. It was therefore recommended that Subject be interned and given a further interrogation by RIP (sic).

4. This office has no objection to the Bureau making the above information available to the other officially interested U.S. Government agencies as deemed advisable.
