Report #9 ("Indications")

Reference: "Traber"

Head of this concern was SS-Troopführer "BRITTON", Fritz, who was special friend of HITLER's; he had his summer home in "Münchheim" (near Scharow) in the actors' settlement.

The offices of the Traber were camouflaged "castles" offices! One of the directors was a Dr. L'KREMER (also SS-Führer!), Nikolaus-See.

FRANKE's secretary was SS-Führer Max PRITZNER, last residence: Malensee, Westfälische Str. 24. His secretary in turn, was Frau Gene-Claire FANTHARD, "Münchheim". At the time of the evacuation of Berlin, they all moved to Schwereide near Ruhland, Niederlausitz, to Saufenberg and to Zeitz, "Germany". The Traber was a German government foundation (Reichs-Stiftung) of the years 1934/35!

This division of the "castles" acquired the estate PRITZNER (near "ruhl", Niederlausitz), after they had sent the owner, Baron von ST. STUCKEN, to a concentration camp.

The central office was in Berlin, an Schinkel-Platz (I think it was) No. 1, however, the number can no longer be ascertained without witnesses, due to the damage. Underneath the debris of the house lies the safe containing very important personnel and other files, and (probably) also hidden valuables. I shall establish the exact location of this cellar containing the safe, as well as the present whereabouts of the individual personalities involved, and then report the findings in detail there.
