TRANSMISSION

Report of ("Indienamt")

Reference: "Tauben,"

Head of this concern was SS-Hauptsturmführer FRITZKÖHL, Fritz, who was special friend of HITLER's; he had his summer home in Blumberg (near Salzwedel) in the eastern settlement.

The offices of the Fräher were centralized Gestapo offices! One of the directors was a Dr. L'XXXENSKI (also SS-Officer), Blumberg-Sie.

TRANSPOT secretary was SS-Untersturmführer MAX PRÖCHTER, last residence: Malente, Westfalenstr. 21. His secretary in turn, was Frau Anna-Claire FLEMMING, Unterstr. 40/b1. At the time of the evacuation of Berlin, they all moved to Schenckendorff near Badland, Niedersachsen, to Salzberg and to Seide, "Haus". The Fräher was a German government foundation (Reichs-/Bundes-) of the years 1931/32!

This division of the "Gestapo" "acquired" the estate PRÖCHTER (near "Rund, Niedersachsen"), after they had sent the owner, Baron von ST. STRICKEN, to a concentration camp.

The central office was in Berlin, on Schinkel-Platz (I think it was) No. 1, however, the number can no longer be ascertained without witnesses, due to the damage. Underneath the debris of this house lies the safe containing very important personnel and other files, and (probably) also hidden valuables. I shall establish the exact location of this cellar containing the safe, as well as the present whereabouts of the individual personalities involved, and then report the facts as in detail there.
