4. DETAILS OF ARREST:

1044888, charged with being SO-OWO-STUMMUNWEN, was arrested by SPO SIG. T. G. III. at TROFINGER-CORLE in 20 April 1947 and was received at Internment Camp #24 on 22 May 1947.

5. FINDINGS:

Subject was a member of the Party from 1933 to 1944, when he was expelled because he took part in the plot against the life of Hitler. He was tried by a Volksgericht on 14 April 1945 and sentenced to two years imprisonment for connections with the enemy. Subject was a O-10. HILFSGEMEINER and a HILFSGEMEINER in the Ordnungspolizei. As Section Chief in the Reichswehrministerium in BERLIN. In 1943 subject received the national rank of O-10. In the alignment-03. In July 1944 subject was expelled from the SA, because he took part in the plot on Hitler's life in July 1944. Subject had been a member of the Sicherheitsdienst or the Reichswehrministerium, as charged in his arrest report. Subject fell at one time under automatic arrest category, but not anymore.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS:

Release is recommended.
