Subject was arrested 28/4/47 as an AAO by this organisation.

attempted assessmation of Adelf HITER on 20 July 44. Subject
was them released upon orders from Eq 970th CIC, Region VIII.

b. Records indicate that Subject(e only connections with the plot were through his friendship with General HERIS. Subject's only part in plot appears to be an assignment as a chamfer in order to drive General HERIS to a certain place at a certain time, which Subject was nover called upon to do. Subject was arrested by the Hasis not because any councetion was made with Subject regarding his part in the plot, but because of his alone friendship with General HERIS. The lightness of sentence imposed on Subject appears to verify this.

- e. Records do not reveal Subject as having connections with any other members for the planning and execution of the plet, although Subject was known to other members by virtue of his high position in the Kriminel Police and in the SS. These persons whom the records name are either dead or missing.
- d. Subject was considered for employment with this Region in June 47. However, due to past connections and affiliations Subject was considered unfit for employment with this organization in any capacity whatever.

a. All known facts tend to indicate that Subject has always carefully considered all condition and angles before taking any chance or any side of any question in de-bt. While Subject states that he fully and firmly believed in the principles of the Mani Party until 1930, it has come to the attention of the undersigned Agent that Subject did not change his opinion of the Mani Party until 1948 at which time military events clearly indicated that Germany was suffering a severe setback and was probably going to look the war. This conclusion was stated by

Rudelf LIBSIGKEIT Born:8 Nov 1806 in Koenigeborg (083/9 40) Present Address: Striin-Steglits, Pabecketr 61 Occupation: Pormer Eriminal Policeman

who further pictured Subject as a famatic Hasi whose repeated attempts to gain membership in the 85 were refused because of Subject's short stature. It was only through the intersection of General HERES that Subject was allowed to join the Hasi Party, It is indicated that Subject and his friend General HERES attempted to use their position in the Hasi Party and also in the 85 to further their sum interests, namegir, self-protection. Provious to his arrost in 1844 Subject gave he indication of being anti-Masi, but rather that he was willing to "play ball" as long as he could hold his position in the Kriminal Police.

b. All of the close friends and business associates of Subject who did maintain contact with Subject from 1868 until 1846 have either been killed or have disappeared. Although many Corumn claim to have been active participants in the plot, none can produce sufficient evidence to substantiate their claims. It is therefore virtually impossible to locate or contact at rue participant in the plot.

e. The undersigned agent in the espatity of investigator vishes to make no recommendations regarding the advisability of hiring or not hiring Subject. It is for the agency concerned to determine from the foregoing information which is evaluated 0-8.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS:

a. It is recommended that a copy of this report be forwarded to requesting agency.
