1. The following information has been furnished by L would appreciate having cos check the Air Force for any information it may have on sites mentioned.

- 2. The Pustnits-Pasqueten site, a former tar sirfield and naval plane base which the Russians took over in 1965 and converted into a ship-building yard specializing in constructin; cutters which ment to the Soviets as reparations, is presently cin; reconverted to its original purpose as an air base. Rursays are min; constructed on shat the local populace considers an emergenc; schedule. Two hundred and fifty of the shippard employees have already been dismissed and have been rabbed by flismit AO for the uranium mines. The remaining employees are likely to lose their jobs by 1 September, the date generally considered as a deadline for Puetnitz as a shipbuilding pard. Thereafter, it will be a Soviet air base.
- 3. Two additional hangars are unser construction. The old living quarters in the vicinity of Pustnitz are being readied for occupancy. capacity is estimated at about 5000 men. The air base will house turbine medium bomners, not jet planes. The same applies to airfields under construction at lart, Peansmuends and Markgrafenheids, in the vicinity of Warnesdinde.
- i. The hangers are hard to observe from the air as they are hidden in woods and shrubbery. They are easily accessible, however, from the Sodden, a waterway separating Ribnits from Dangarton.
