1. Subject's name is [] She was born on 30 December 1902 in Cula a.d. Weichsel and is single. Prior to moving into the safe house she lived at 29 Gubener Strasse, Berlin SO (Soviet Sector). She carried East Zone credentials (DPA) Nr. 10372/49 issued 13 January 1949 by the Police Precinct Station No. 90. At the request of BOB she was issued a residential permit (Zusugsgenehmigung) for the U.S. Sector of Berlin. She has turned in her East Zone credentials and been issued West Sector credentials instead.

2. From 1917 to 1922 subject worked as a clerical employee first for the District Commissioner (Landrat) of Cula a./w, next for the Machine Construction firm Peters in Cula. From 1922 to 1924 she was a clerk in the employ of the Red Cross in the Refugee Camp at Güstrow/Mecklenburg. From 13 December 1924 until May 1945 she was a Criminal Police employee in the Polizeipräsidium of Berlin.

3. Subject's parents are deceased. Two brothers and two sisters live in territories under Allied jurisdiction. One of her sisters, [] born on 16 July 1912, lives at 53 Berner Strasse, Berlin-Lichterfelde.

4. Subject is 48 years of age.
